#### **THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:**

<u>Count 1</u> [Felon in Possession of a Firearm – Armed Career Criminal]

On or about January 15, 2014, in the District of Oregon, DOUGLAS ANTHONY

LYONS, defendant herein, having been previously convicted of a crime punishable by

imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, specifically:

- A. Assault in the Second Degree, Burglary in the First Degree, and Delivery of a Controlled Substance Schedule II, on or about August 8, 2005, in the State of Oregon, Multnomah County Circuit Court, Case Number 050130442;
- B. Felony Assault in the Fourth Degree (two counts), on or about November 16,
  2001, in the State of Oregon, Multnomah County Circuit Court, Case Number 01-09-36416;

- C. Felony Attempt to Elude, on or about August 3, 1998, in the State of Oregon,
   Multnomah County Circuit Court, Case Number C9801-30438;
- D. Delivery of a Controlled Substance II and Supplying Contraband, on or about November 12, 1996, in the State of Oregon, Multnomah County Circuit Court, Case Number C960634857; and,
- E. Possession of a Controlled Substance II, on or about September 20, 1996, in the
   State of Oregon, Multnomah County Circuit Court, Case Number C9510-37959,

did knowingly and unlawfully possess the following firearm, to-wit: a Dan Wesson Arms Revolver, .357 Caliber, Serial Number 148250, which had previously been transported in interstate commerce, all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(e).
